HOW TO REGISTER

Please complete a Registration form (NHS GMS1) and New Patient Questionnaire available from Reception or as a download from our website. **Please provide Photographic Identification in person and also proof of your address.** You are registered with the practice rather than with an individual GP. You may see any of the doctors and can express a preference for which doctor you want to see, subject to availability. You will also be invited to make a New Patient Appointment with the Practice Nurse.

PRESCRIPTIONS

The Surgery dispenses drugs to all patients living more than one mile from their nearest Chemist. PLEASE INFORM US OF YOUR PREFERRED HOME SITE.

Repeat Prescriptions may be requested in any of the following ways:

- By placing a slip in the box on the reception counter
- By posting a slip through the letterbox when we are closed
- By post to The Heddingham Medical Centre
- Online via the link on our website or at www.patient-access.co.uk (Please ask at reception for a leaflet on how to register for this service)

Please allow 3 working days for your prescription to be filled before collection.

RING NHS 111

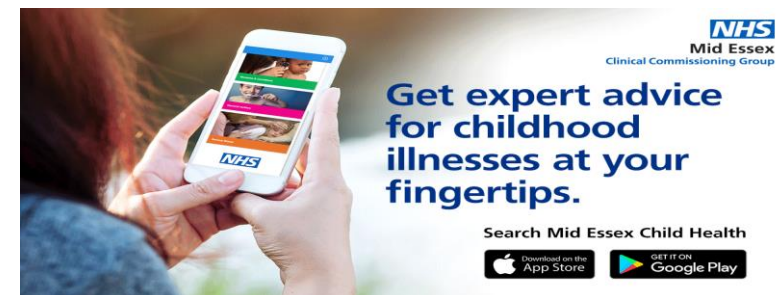
